

4TH AVENUE WELL PROJECT

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE - 10/24/2020

Salt Lake City Department of Public Utilities (SLCDPU) construction contractor

VanCon is preparing the 4th Avenue well site to begin construction early next week.

The expected completion date for this project is June 1, 2021.

Here's what to expect at this time:

- A construction staging area will be set up on the bridge on 4th Avenue with traffic control signs
- Tree preservation fencing to establish a tree protection zone
- Rocky Mountain Power will disconnect the power from the well and the park's lighting
- Equipment will be placed on site and pre-well drilling work such as video and alignment testing conducted

During this time, you can anticipate some noise as equipment is being brought in and set up. Construction work will take place Monday through Friday from 8 am to 5 pm. We will continue to keep you updated on the project and its expected impacts. We do not anticipate any water service shutdowns to your home or business during this project.

About The Project

Salt Lake City Department of Public Utilities (SLCDPU) plans to upgrade the well to meet current safety and environmental requirements to ensure it continues to provide clean and reliable drinking water. The well is at severe risk of failure as the electrical system is outdated and the well head and electrical components are located in a subsurface vault. This does not meet current drinking water regulations or electrical codes and is an unsafe working environment for workers.
